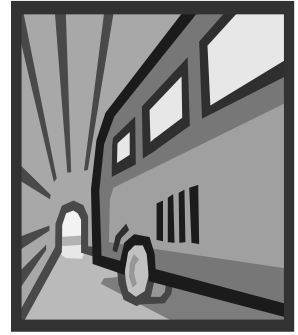


## ***Getting to Work in DeKalb County***
